

The Garden Master Community Garden Project Installation Rules

The Garden Master does not plan and organize the Saturday community garden projects. These are after all community projects designed to bring families and communities together for the united purpose of sustainability. It is the responsibility of each community to organize and manage their own projects and sustainability with the assistance and guidance of the Garden Master.

The family or families committed to installing a garden shall inform/educate other families in their community as to the process and organize a group of families who are committed to installing a garden on an agreed upon specific date and time.

WHEN IN ARIZONA:

This group shall appoint a leader who shall set a Saturday for at least four to six gardens to be installed and shall arrange the delivery of bedding sand to their homes by a reputable company. The Garden Master will provide the names of the companies in your area that have agreed to a reasonable price for the correct bedding sand and delivery. The leader shall provide the Garden Master with the names, addresses and garden descriptions to be published in the Garden Master Weekly Newsletter both "Tentatively" and "Ready Now" in order to notify all volunteers of the garden projects locations. With at least four gardens organized for installation in the same community on the same Saturday the Leader may invite the Garden Master to attend and assist. The Garden Master will attend to teach and assist.

WHEN IN OTHER STATES:

This group shall appoint a leader who shall set a Saturday for at least twelve to sixteen gardens to be installed and shall arrange the delivery of bedding sand to their homes by a reputable company. The Garden Master will assist in the location of companies in your area that will agree to a reasonable price for the correct bedding sand and delivery. The leader shall provide the Garden Master with the names, addresses and garden descriptions to be published in the Garden Master Weekly Newsletter both "Tentatively" and "Ready Now" in order to notify all volunteers of the garden projects locations. With at least twelve gardens organized for installation in the same or close communities on the same weekend, in addition to travel and lodging arrangements for the Garden Master, the Leader may invite the Garden Master to attend for that weekend to assist. The Garden Master will attend to teach and assist for the weekend.

WHEN IN OTHER COUNTRIES

This group shall appoint a leader who shall set a weekend for at least twenty four to thirty two gardens to be installed and shall arrange the delivery of bedding sand to their homes by a reputable company or provide instruction on the screening of your own sand. The Garden Master will assist in the location of companies in your area that will agree to a reasonable price for the correct bedding sand and delivery. The leader shall provide the Garden Master with the names, addresses and garden descriptions to be published in the Garden Master Weekly Newsletter both "Tentatively" and "Ready Now" in order to notify all volunteers of the garden projects locations.

With at least twenty four gardens organized for installation, in addition to travel and lodging arrangements for the Garden Master, the Leader may invite the Garden Master to attend for that weekend or a specific time during the week to assist. The Garden Master will attend to teach and assist for the time period agreed upon.

It is important that you plan and submit your garden project information to the Garden Master at least three weeks in advance of the installation date to insure that your information is published in the Garden Master Newsletter. If it is your intention to invite the Garden Master to assist with and teach at your installation you must submit an invitation to him four weeks prior to your projected project installation date.

It is the responsibility of each individual and their community leaders to be sure that you read and understand the Garden Master Bucket Garden and accessories ordering and shipping rules. Please be sure to read all of the material on “The Bucket Garden” page at www.TheGardenMaster.com and understand it before you order. **You must order your Bucket Garden Kit and Supplies at least 10 days prior to your projected garden installation date in Arizona and 15 days prior to your installation date if you are outside of Arizona or outside the United States.**
